





### Front View




### Rear View



### Left View





## Indicators

Icon	What it means when lit
	Hard disk drive active.
	Standby mode on.
	Caps lock on.
	Num lock on.
	Scroll lock on.
<b>Turbo</b>	Turbo mode is active.
	Computer power is on. (Blinking indicates Suspend mode is active.)
	Modular bay device is latched.

## Special Function Keys

Fn +	Function	Fn +	Function
	Saves to disk—saves current state of computer and turns off power.		Increases screen brightness.
	Goes into Suspend mode; turns off screen and hard disk drive. Press <b>Shift</b> to end Suspend mode.		Decreases screen brightness.
	Goes into Standby mode; turns off screen. Press <b>Shift</b> to end Standby mode.		Toggles sound on and off.
	Toggles Scroll Lock function.		Increases volume.
	Toggles Num Lock function; activates embedded numeric keypad.		Decreases volume.
	Toggles between external monitor and screen.
