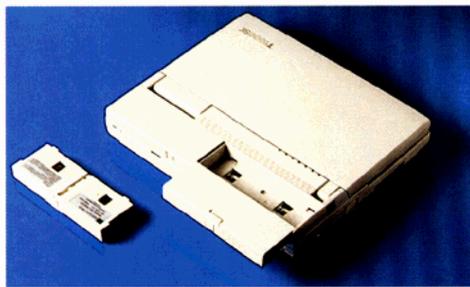
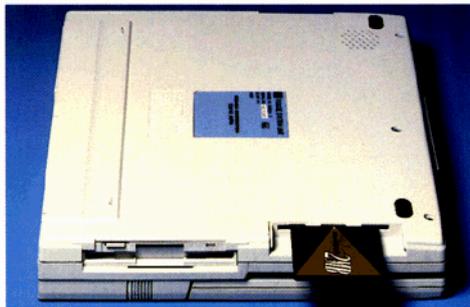

The T1000SE is designed to give industry-standard performance in the smallest possible package. The key to the MS-DOS world is the Intel 80C86™ microprocessor running at 9.54 MHz. The high-resolution Supertwist display uses technology which helps reduce the overall size of the T1000SE while at the same time giving maximum readability. The new ultra-thin diskette drive uses the industry-standard 3.5" 1.44 MB/720 KB format to ensure easy file transfer to standard office PCs. The drive is equipped with a feature that automatically senses whether 1.44 MB or 720 KB diskettes are being used. Despite its small footprint, the T1000SE comes with a full-size 84-key keyboard and standard Centronics parallel and RS 232C serial interfaces for connecting printers and other peripherals.

Once again Toshiba has found clever ways to provide maximum utility, ergonomics, and power in a small, neat package. MS-DOS 3.3 comes built into ROM so no MS-DOS diskette is required. The 1 MB of standard RAM can be expanded to up to 3 MB using handy, user-installable RAM cards. You can use the extra RAM above 640 KB as a fast battery-backed Hard RAM disk for up to 2.3 MB additional disk storage space. AutoResume™ is a popular Toshiba feature that offers a quick start, remembering where you left off when you were last working. The T1000SE cannot be turned on when the lid is down, preventing accidental power on and unnecessary battery drain during transport. The T1000SE battery is removable and rechargeable so you can carry extra batteries to extend operating time as long as you want. A slot for a built-in modem is standard and makes the T1000SE an effective portable platform for communications. So wherever you are, you can keep in touch with headquarters. But most importantly, you get Toshiba rugged quality and reliability. And Toshiba service. Quick. Professional. Worldwide.
