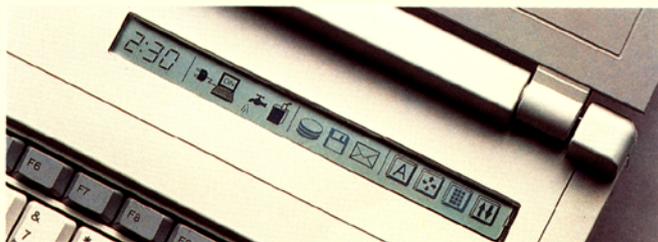
won't even need our Desk Station thanks to its enhanced PCMCIA 2.0 slot which will accept expansion cards from
